Privacy & data protection policy

Introduction

Organisers of the 1st FIPS-Mouche World Ladies Fly Fishing Championship (WLFFC) and the 26th FIPS-Mouche European Fly Fishing Championship (EFFC), further called WLFFCEFFC. The organisers handling your personal information in a safe and secure manner, in accordance with current regulations. Below you will find information about how we handle personal information that we collect from users of our websites, through membership with us, or your participation in WLFFC or EFFC 2022.

The organisers of WLFFCEFFC are responsible for the processing of the personal data that we have registered and processes about you based on your membership with us, or your participation in the 1st WLFFC or the 26th EFFC. Personal information is all information that can be linked to you as a person.

In 2018, the EU's General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) was introduced for Norway. One of the basic requirements for the processing of personal data is that the processing must be fair and open.

Through this privacy policy, you get information about what personal information we process about you, how this personal data is processed and what rights you have in connection with this.

You agree to this privacy policy by participating in either the 1st WLFFC or the 26th EFFC 2022.

We register this personal information about you

In connection with your participation in either the 1st WLFFC or the 26th EFFC, WLFFCEFFC will process and store several such personal information about you. You provide us with some of this information, while others come from third parties (such as banks, etc.), see more about this under each type of information.

In our systems, name, address, age category (senior), gender, e-mail address, telephone number, account number.

WLFFCEFFC receive this information from you through your participation in the 1st WLFFC or the 26th EFFC and WLLFEFFC store the information mentioned above.

The information is deleted after 10 years unless special new circumstances indicate that it must be preserved longer, such as list and results.

If you notify of matters worthy of criticism, information about you as a notifier will be stored. Information about you will also be stored if others give such notifications about you. This will be stored in a separate area for this which will then only be available to those who have a service need for it.

Open personal data

To work as an effective association, it is necessary to share some information internally within WLFFCEFFC, including information about you. The information we share internally is considered not to pose a risk to the individual's fundamental rights and freedoms, while the WLFFCEFFC's legitimate interest in sharing such information internally and externally is considered vital.

Such open personal data includes name, age category, team, photo, film, participation the 1st WLFFC or the 26th EFFC and result.

The purposes of the processing of your personal data

Here you get an overview of the most important purposes of the processing of your personal data. We process personal information about you to fulfil our obligations as a union to you and to public authorities.

For the operation of WLFFCEFFC, we need to process and store data about your identity, your participation in either the 1st WLFFC or the 26th EFFC and your result.

We want to use photos / film to market the 1st WLFFC and the 26th EFFC. It may happen that photos / film of you are taken during events. If you do not want us to use photos / film of you from your participation in either the 1st WLFFC or the 26th EFFC (fishing situations, banquet, prize giving, etc.), we ask you to give us explicit notice of this. Please note that you can notify us at any time. Withdrawal of consent will not automatically influence already produced brochures, publications on websites or the like.

Legal basis for the processing of your personal data

The most important legal basis for us as organizers of the 1st WLFFC and the 26th EFFC to process personal data about you as a participant is:

- that we are required to do so by law.
- that we as the organizer of the 1st WLFFC and the 26th EFFC have a legitimate interest that exceeds the privacy disadvantages that you incur.
- that you have consented to the treatment through your participation in either the 1st WLFFC or the 26th EFFC.

These legal bases follow from the EU Regulation on Privacy, GDPR Article 6.

Cookies

Cookies are small text files that the website asks to be stored on the user's computer or mobile device.

We use cookies on our websites and social media. Cookies are primarily used to measure traffic and optimize service. We use cookies only to analyse the general user pattern on wlffceffc.com and to improve the website for users.

We will not process personal data for marketing purposes unless we have obtained consent to do so. You can at any time declare that you no longer wish to receive inquiries by sending us an e-mail.

Use of cookies on third party websites

We also use cookies through our presence in social media. When you visit our pages in social media, the social media channels collect personal information that is used to compile statistics. WLFFCEFFC does not have access to the personal information collected, but we do have access to anonymised statistics compiled by the social media channel based on the information collected.

The cookies and data collected are anonymised and do not contain personal information.

Most browsers automatically accept cookies. You can prevent cookies from being stored on your computer by changing your browser setting.

Public authorities

Public authorities may require us to provide personal information about our members.

Where in the world do we process information about you?

Your personal information is stored primarily on servers located in Norway, there may also be storage on other servers within the EEA, the EU, the Israel and the USA.

If we store your personal information

We store personal information about you for as long as is necessary for our processing and in accordance with storage requirements in law. In connection with your participation, it is necessary to keep information about you, but when the championships are over, we will delete much of the information.

Your rights as a participant

As a participant in either the 1st WLFFC or the 26th EFFC you have according to Lov om behandling av personopplysninger (personopplysningsloven) and EUs General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) several rights. Here is an overview of the most important. If you are unsure or have questions about any of these rights, you can contact our data controller (see contact information at the bottom of this document).

You can request information about how we process your personal information, and as a rule you have the right to access the information, we process about you. If you discover errors in information about you, you can demand that these be corrected. You can also demand that information be deleted, but this does not apply where the law requires storage or where we believe there is a basis for storage. If you disagree with the assessment we make, you can complain to us and you can complain to the Datatilsynet. Furthermore, you can request that we limit the processing of personal data, and you have the right to so-called data portability (that we transfer personal data about you to other companies).

Furthermore, you have the right to oppose our use of personal information. However, then you will not be able to participate in either the 1st WLFFC or the 26th EFFC where the publication of results is to be expected.

Where you disagree with our processing of personal data, you can complain to Datatilsynet, but to resolve any misunderstandings, we encourage you to first address this internally through our data controller (see contact information at the bottom of this document).

If you wish to exercise your rights and contact us about this, we will give you feedback as soon as possible and no later than within 30 days. If it takes longer, we will inform about it.

Changes to our privacy policy

This privacy policy was last updated on 14th of February 2022. We reserve the right to change it from time to time and encourage you to familiarize yourself with the contents of the policy on a regular basis.
